

CHAMBER ENERGY AGGREGATION PROGRAM

Community Energy Advisors (CEA), in conjunction with local Chambers of Commerce, have partnered to offer Chamber members an exclusive opportunity to save money on their electricity and natural gas bills. This program is designed to create additional buying power, create market competition for the Chamber members' business, and drive energy prices down.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who is eligible to participate?

Must be a commercial member of a Chamber of Commerce.

What price will members receive by joining?

This program has been developed to pool all customers to increase buying power making volume very important. The more participants in the program, the more leverage there is to drive prices down. By expanding the market and competition, this program enables small and mid-sized business owners to achieve pricing comparable to a very large user, resulting in significant savings.

What about large business owners?

CEA will shop the marketplace to obtain individual, custom pricing for businesses that use over 1,000 Mwh per year in electricity or 1,000 MCF per year in natural gas, by accessing a large network of competitive suppliers.

How do I know if I'm already in a contract?

Look for a supplier, other than the utility, listed on your bill or simply contact CEA and we can help you.

Do I have to wait until my current contract ends?

No. Contact us and we can help you to identify if you are in a contract and if so, when your contract ends to determine the best time to enroll you in the program for future savings.

What is the Third Party Authorization for?

The Third Party Authorization enables the program to secure the best product and price combination on behalf of all participating members each month. Chamber members other than those defined as Mercantile will have the right to rescind their enrollment with the retail supplier within seven (7) calendar days following the postmark date on the utility's confirmation notice.

How long will my supplier contract through the Chamber Energy Aggregation Program last?

Your contract term will be 24 months.

ENROLLMENT

Open Enrollment Schedule

Aggregate RFP's are conducted multiple times throughout each month. Once your information is submitted for review and your eligibility to participate in the program is confirmed, you will be placed in the next available aggregation.

CEA will provide a copy of the supplier's terms and conditions prior to enrollment. At the conclusion of each enrollment period, participating Chamber members will receive a transaction confirmation detailing their new energy supplier, rate, and contract term.

How to Enroll in the Chamber Energy Aggregation Program

1. Download and complete the *Third Party Authorization Form*
2. Scan and email the following documents to chamberenergy@ceateam.com
 - Signed Third Party Authorization
 - Most recent gas and/or electric bill for each account (*all pages*)
 - Any current supply contracts (*if applicable*)
3. We will be in touch with you to confirm your eligibility to participate
